MINUTES OF BSA VILLAGE HALL MEETING 5 MAY 2008

The committee were happy with the accounts and agreed that they could be printed. Chris also explained that with the £500 outgoing to Anglian Water that the accounts were tight at the moment. We have a few bookings, and with the rent to come from LMRC in May we will have to be careful.

Letter of thanks to Lincoln Model Railway Club for their help and support in converting the kitchen.
