Face covering exemptions

You do not need to wear a face covering if you have a legitimate reason not to.

- Young children under the age of 11
- mental illness or impairment, or disability
- If you are travelling with or providing assistance to someone who relies on lip reading

There are also scenarios when you are permitted to remove a face covering when asked:

- If asked to do so by shop staff for the purpose of age identification If speaking with people who rely on lip reading, facial expressions and clear sound. Some may ask you, either verbally or in writing, to remove a covering to help with communication


